But don't think twice it's alright

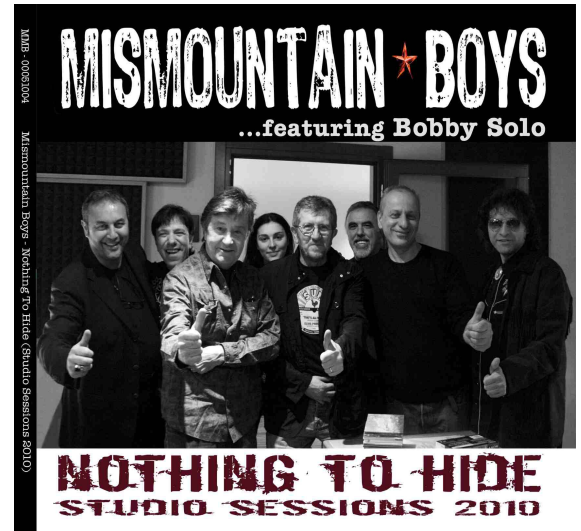
And it ain't no use in turning on your light babe

Oh, Lord, stuck in Lodi again

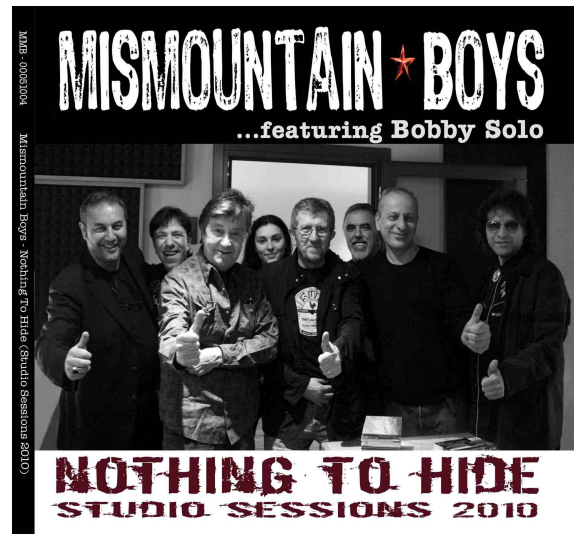
The man from the magazine, Said I was on my way

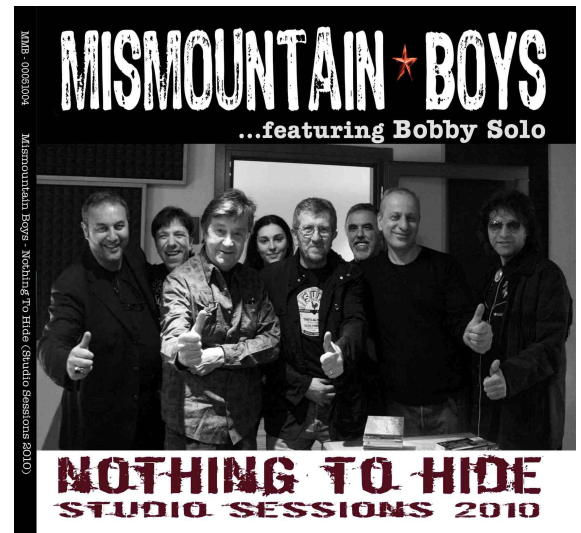
Lost On The River

your face!*

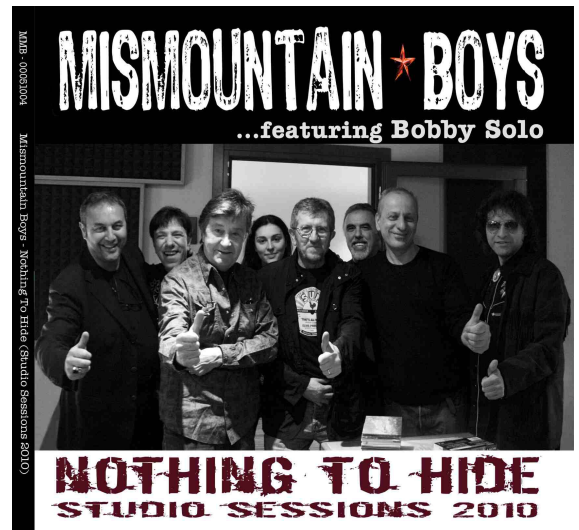

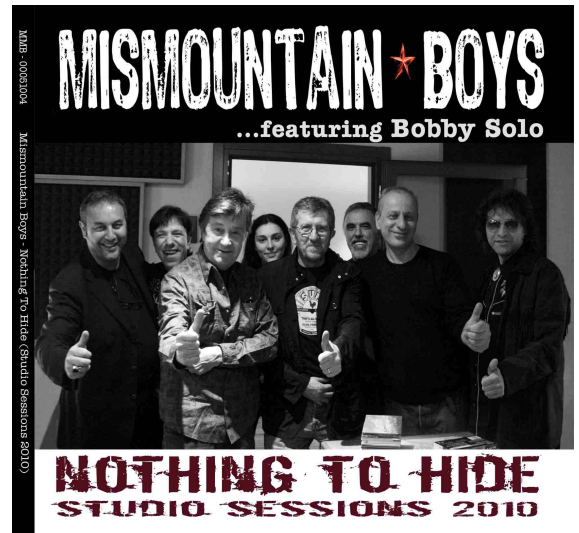
Blue Eyes Crying In The Rain

Shine on the one that's gone and left me blue

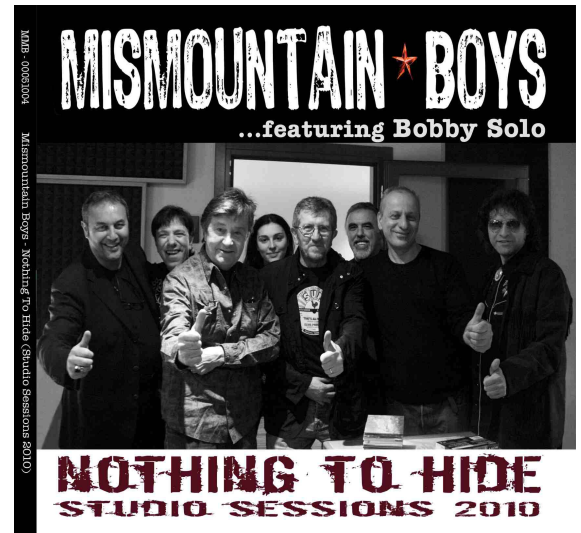

The home of Davy Crockett in the hills of Tennessee

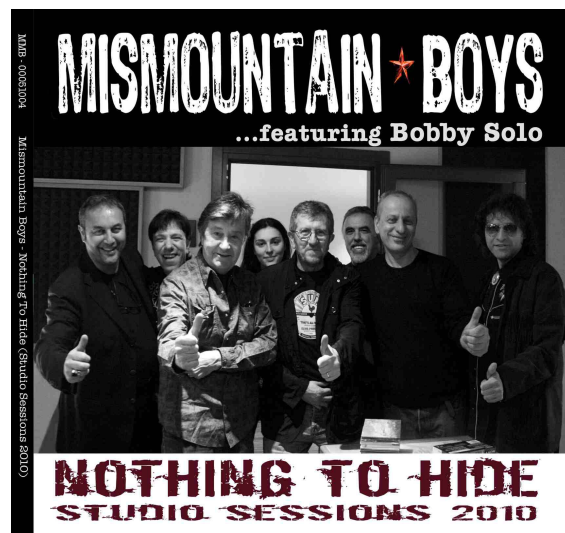
When I was a little boy around the folks back home
